Recommended Oil Colors

Use either Utrecht brand, Winsor & Newton, or Gamblin. These are all high quality paints that are reasonably priced.

Titanium White- I recommend this option for the white

Ultramarine Blue
Ivory Black

Dioxazine Purple
Gamblin brand transparent earth yellow, red, and orange (really nice colors to use if you choose to work with Galkyd Lite medium.

Galkyd Lite

Linseed Oil

You're welcome to experiment with anything that interests you or start using none at all.

Canvas

Start with 3-4 canvases. Size is your choice. It is good to have a few at a time.

If you choose to get Galkyd Lite for your medium I recommend wood panels instead of canvas.

Brushes

I recommend getting a couple of these synthetic brush in a flat size 10 and bigger.
